MAKE-UP ESSAYS For All Dance Classes

<u>Task</u>: The student will develop an understanding about the dance world today.

Assignment:

- * Find and photocopy a three to four page article from one of the following magazines: Dance International, Dance Magazine, DanceTeacher, and Pointe.
- * Read the article and write a four paragraph essay based on the article:
 - Paragraph #1: include general information, such as the title of the article, the author, the title of the magazine and it's issue number, and an overview of the article.
 - Paragraph #2-3: summarize the article.
 - Paragraph #4: give your opinion about the article with a clear reason for liking or disliking it. Be sure to give examples from the article to support your opinion.
- * Each paragraph should be four to six sentences, at least.
- * The essay is to be written on the front of two pieces of paper. **DO NOT WRITE ON**THE BACK OF ANY PAPER!!!
- * The grading scale for all essays is as follows: Paragraph #1 will be worth ten (10) points. Paragraphs #2-4 will be worth thirty (30) points each. This gives a total of 100 points per essay.

DANCE ESSAY CHECKLIST

- 1. Use **only** black or blue ink.
- 2. Name, Date, Class Period in upper left hand corner.
- 3. Create a title and write it in the center of the top line.
- 4. Skip the next line and start writing/typing on the second line.
- 5. Do not write past the red margins on both sides of the paper.
- 6. Do not forget to indent each paragraph.
- 7. Write in complete sentence form with no abbreviations or contractions and be sure to spell out all numbers under one hundred.
- 8. Do not write on the last two lines of the paper. (Do not count the spaces; count the actual lines.)
- 9. **Do not** write on the back side of your paper.
- 10. Do not write your name and/or date at the end of your essay.
- 11. Staple your completed essay on top of your notes/article and turn it in to the top shelf on the teacher's desk.
